## **Leadership Teams:**

There are three leadership teams each session. Each team will concentrate on one particular issue during the first week of camp and will do service in all of the other issue areas during the second week. Campers can rank their preferences in their confirmation packet.

Public Health & Education: Tutor preschool children and visit seniors.

Environment Team: Protect the outdoors by painting, wrapping trees & removing plants. All outdoors!

Hunger & Homelessness Team: Cook lunch at a soup kitchen and volunteer at a shelter.

Each team consists of 10 students and one highly qualified staff member.

## **Service Sites**

- Service sites are unique to each session and focus on homelessness, education, environment and health.
- All service sites are safe, fun places that have extensive experience working with groups of youth.
- Service site schedules will be available on the first day of camp.
- Transportation to and from service sites will be provided in 15-passenger mini-buses driven by camp staff.

## **Registration**

- Registration begins April 5th for Ken-Caryl residents and April 12th for non-residents.

## **Registration Fees**

Tuition for the two-week session:

Ken-Caryl Resident      \$340 per two-week session

Non-Resident            \$380 per two-week session

Tuition includes all camp activities and supplies, field trip and transportation costs, and two camp t-shirts. Campers provide their own lunches.
